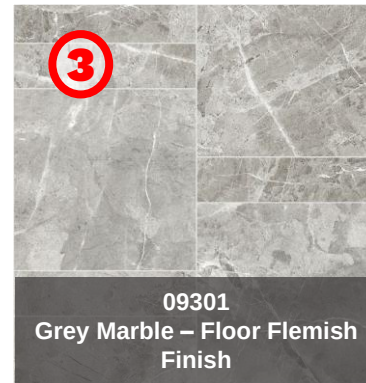
GROUND FLOOR RECEPTION



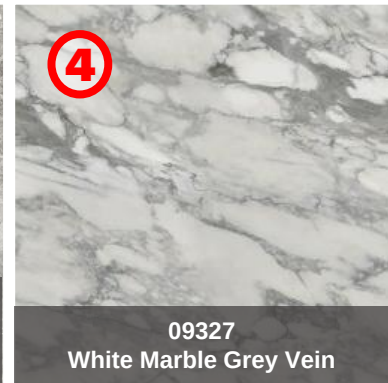

Fluted



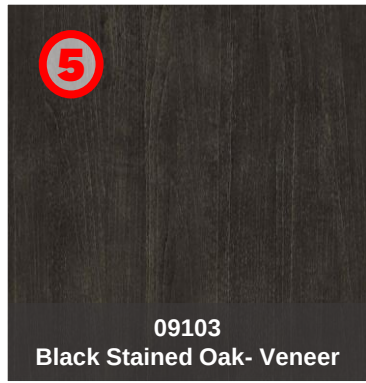

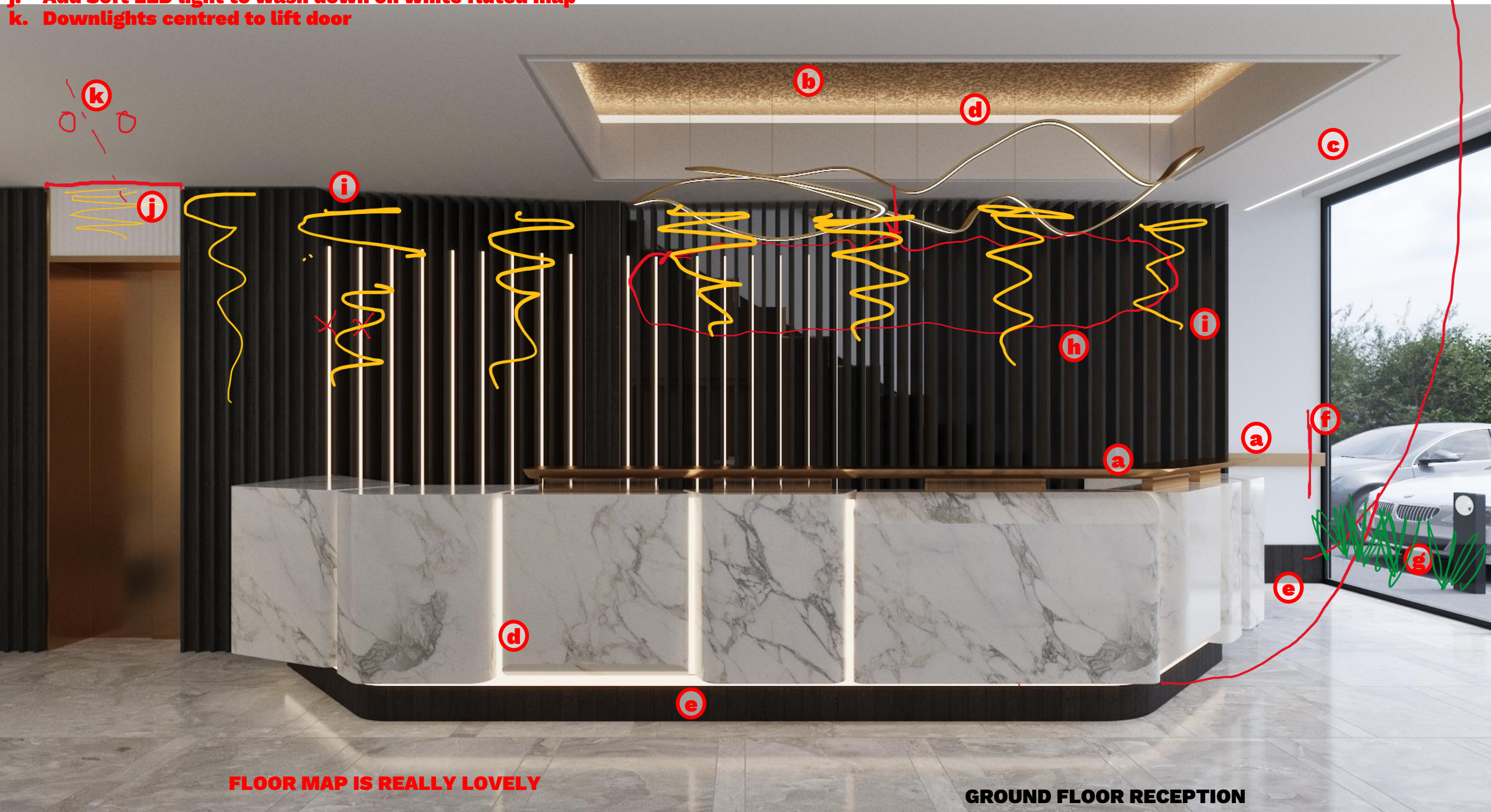
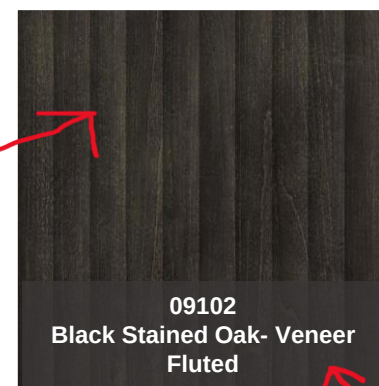


Bush Hammered Bronze

- a. Material to be less gold and more bronze
- b. Bush hammer texture not quite right, map seems dirty and too gold
- c. No LED in this recess
- d. All LEDs to have less of a harsh straight line to them, softer emitting glow – MUSTNT SEE LIGHT SOURCE
- e. Timber fluted skirting is very dark- Texture and map incorrect – see 01 on previous slide
- f. Cut back railing 100mm if possible
- g. Add some planters
- h. Drop feature chandelier as shown
- i. Remove LED Strips in screen, wash light down as shown by yellow scribbles
- j. Add Soft LED light to wash down on white fluted map
- k. Downlights centred to lift door



- a. Scale map by down 50% - needs to be smaller. Also a touch too light now.
 - b. Add a soft timber oak map to the wall behind stair.
 - c. Can we add a person? Preferably a Muslim lady (no full burkha though)
 - d. This element behind screen looks too prominent- perhaps we can hide with maps better
 - e. Timber screen texture has gone a bit grey and dull? Preferred the previous draft
 - f. Perhaps we need some lights washing down between some the slats as well? But not as pronounced as previous draft.
- Screen needs to feel evenly lit up.

g. Downlights need to be centered to lift door and 200mm apart from each other- ie closer together

h. Ceiling Recess - Glow was better in previous draft. Hide the strip light source.

i. Gentle LED strip glow underneath brass counter

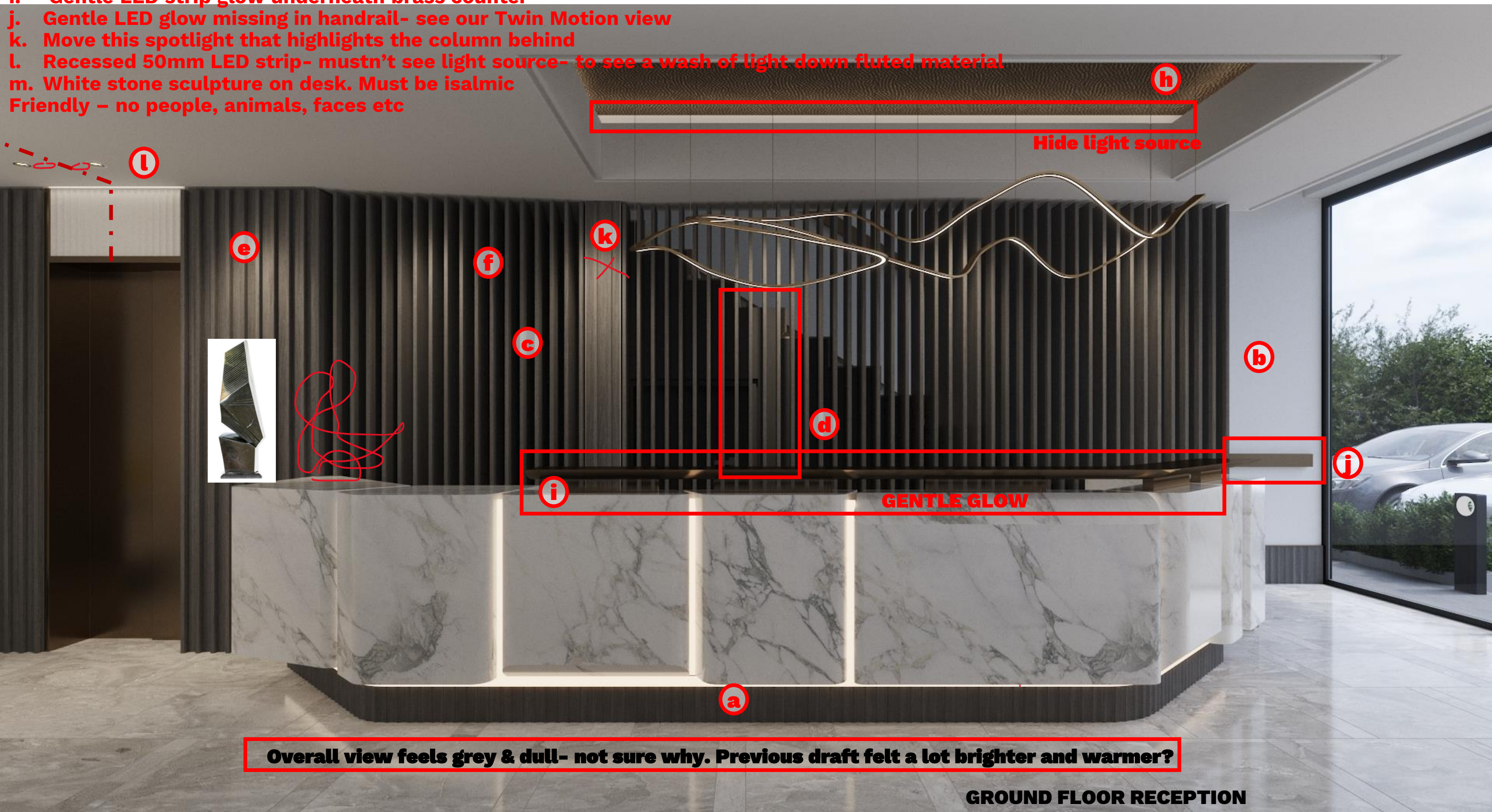
j. Gentle LED glow missing in handrail- see our Twin Motion view

k. Move this spotlight that highlights the column behind

l. Recessed 50mm LED strip- mustn't see light source- to see a wash of light down fluted material

m. White stone sculpture on desk. Must be islamic

Friendly - no people, animals, faces etc



Overall view feels grey & dull- not sure why. Previous draft felt a lot brighter and warmer?

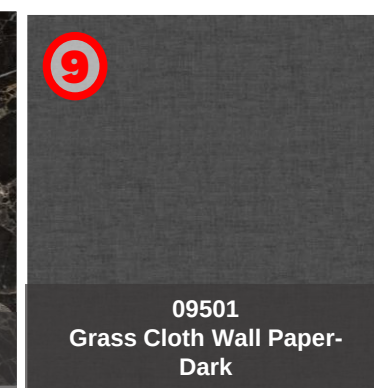
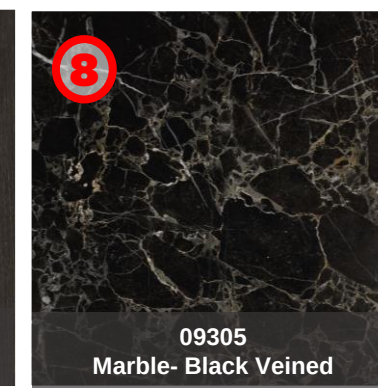
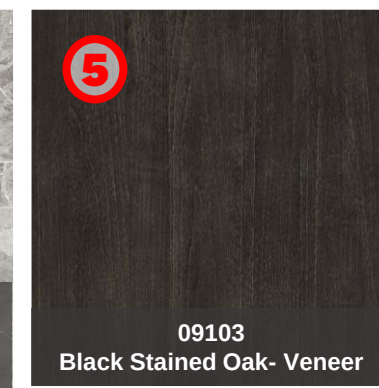
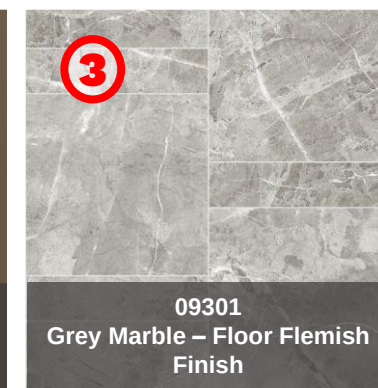
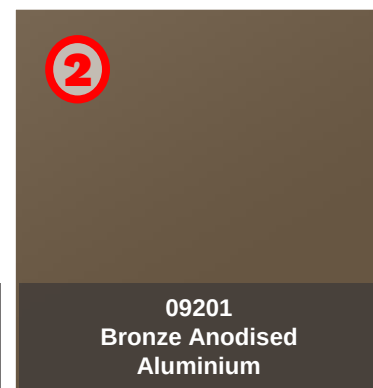
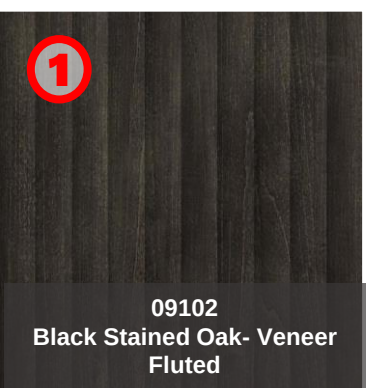

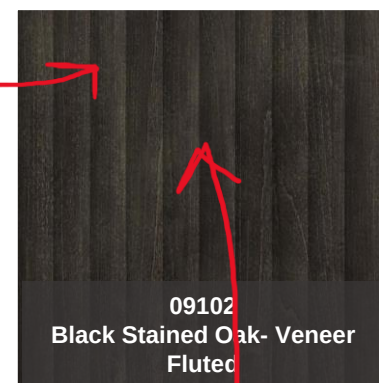

- a. Timber fluted skirting is very dark- Texture and map incorrect – see 01 on previous slide
- b. Light up shelving unit more
- c. Desk incorrect- no return to floor. Desk FBX model sent in email
- d. Center chairs and desk to room.
- e. Make Door white
- f. Add cone lights/ spot lights shining down on casework
- g. Add a curtain
- h. Less chunky arm chairs
- i. Add lamp like our view
- j. Map to rug too busy- could it be something similar to ours
- k. Can we find coffee tables more like ours shown



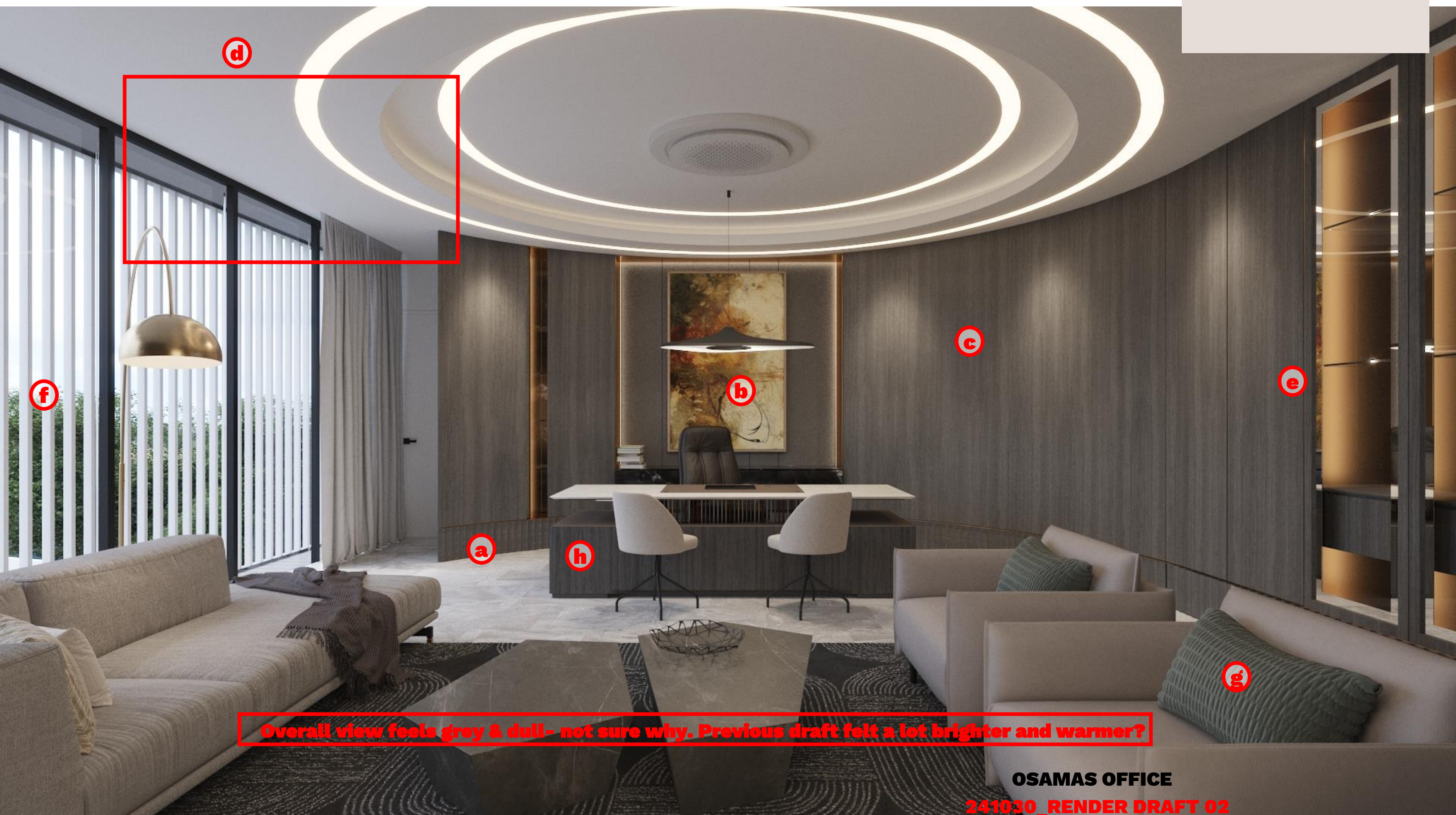
Overall view seems a bit dark/ lacks the glow of warmer lighting

- a. Timber fluted skirting is now a little too light- scale map by 50%
- b. Artwork Map sent
- c. Updated casework and colour map sent (map not great, hope you have a better one)
- d. Track lights missing- in FBX model with Casework
- e. Glass cabinet doors to have bronze frame
- f. External screen to be dark aluminum
- g. Swap out -Match our couches- FBX sent
- h. Timber has gone a touch grey
