- 2) Should you acquire any more vehicles you are to supply the Metro the registration numbers.
- 3) All vehicles, which are used to transport water, must be of a high road worthy standard and must have valid licences.
- 4) Drivers must at all times carry a copy of the letter in the vehicles being used to transport water to prove authenticity. Should there be any queries they can phone the number above or 082 459 7499.
- 5) The water tankers on the back of your flatbed trucks must be at all times securely fastened to ensure that they cannot fall off during transporting.
- 6) To keep records of all deliveries that happen on a daily basis including dates, times, volumes and addresses.
- 7) You are to have sufficient third party or public liability insurances to cover any costs that may arise from an accident.
- 8) This permit will be reviewed annually by the Metro and can be terminated at any stage should the need arise. This permit is there to primarily assist the Metro during the drought and water shortages and is under no circumstances to be abused in any way.
